This provides public notice of the availability of the draft Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives and Remedial Action Plan (ABCA/RAP) for environmental cleanup to be conducted at the above referenced property, for public review and comment. This Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives was prepared as a requirement of the EPA Brownfields Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) grant awarded to the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission, which is providing funding to DevelopSpringfield for the remediation of the Gunn Block. A Public Meeting concerning the draft Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives and on the proposed remediation of the Gunn Block will be held on Tuesday, March 25, 2014, at 6:00 PM at the Springfield Technical Community College, Building 16 in the President's Conference Room, located on Federal Street, Springfield, Massachusetts. Public comments on the draft ABCA/RAP and on the proposed remediations will be accepted at this meeting.

The cleanup activities recommended in the ABCA/RAP include the following:

- Removal and proper disposal of asbestos, lead based paint and universal/hazardous waste from the building while preserving certain elements of historic significance
- Possible removal of small quantities of petroleum impacted soil from the building's basement
